PARLIAMENTARY Parliamentarian Lucy Johnson educated the board on the protocol of Debate and Amendments with multiple choice questions & discussion

PROVINCE DIRECTOR REPORT

Chairman Heiderscheidt spoke about Roe & Dobbs being overturned on Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. NCCW Convention registration opens July 1 and is limited to 480 registrants. Connections have been made with the Crookston Diocese and one of North Dakota's Dioceses. Non-affiliated Dioceses in Province include Crookston and all of North and South Dakota. Board members were encouraged to pray a daily rosary; battles ensue to combat spiritual warfare. Funds for Ukrainian relief are still being collected via the NCCW website (nccw.org) Chairman Heiderscheidt is a member of the Leadership Commission and is working on project Retain, Regain and Grow. Service commission continues their work on promoting the USCCB programs of Walking with Moms in Need & addressing Human Trafficking. Five resolutions were submitted to the Resolutions committee and 1 was approved. The LTD team continues to offer training via zoom. Submission dates for Our Lady of Good Counsel award nominees are June 26-July 9.

Maribeth Stewart, representative of NCCW for WUCWO, participated in the

International Women's Day. The WUCWO General Assembly will be held in Assisi in May 2023. NCCW individual affiliates number 1400. Past NCCW member lists by A/Diocese were handed out to A/Diocesan presidents to call those individuals, encouraging them to affiliate again.

A/DIOCESAN REPORTS

A/Diocesan Presidents of Duluth, New Ulm, St. Cloud, St. Paul/Minneapolis and Winona-Rochester gave their reports.

Duluth - Alice Parendo reported the that letter sent out by their Bishop to Diocesan priests was edited and updated; Are in the process of enacting a 5-year Diocesan plan; will be handing out a questionnaire at fall conference to gain input from members

New Ulm – Jackie Finstad, installed a Diocesan president at NUDCCW Annual Convention. She reported on their annual convention and speakers (250 women attended); Leadership training on May 16 – Donna Sanders and Shirley Nowak led the training; still awaiting and praying for a Bishop to be assigned to their Diocese

St. Cloud – Linda Borgerding reported on their spring Lenten retreat held on March 12; Fun, Food and Fun Fundraiser on June 16 (147 attendess); Aug. 4 pilgrimage to Eastern section of Diocese (Isanti, Elk River) focus on Adoration; Work continues on restructuring of Deaneries, from 7 to 5.

St. Paul/Minneapolis – Mickey Nickelson, Kitui Diocesan; Shared about Synod meeting and question of who would you like to meet if you could ... why didn't I choose the Governor of our State and ask about issues contrary to Catholic teaching – elevator speech; courage; Kitui Dormitory \$50,000 fundraising goal has been met but will continue to fundraise, as the need still exists for funds; project not yet complete; difficult to build consensus via emails; leading is a learning process!

Winona-Rochester – Eleanore Jones reported that they'll be placing an ad from the Council of Catholic Women, welcoming Bishop-elect Robert Barron, due to be installed July 29, 2022. August 13, Spiritual Day of Grace for Women with featured speakers, Fr. Randal Kasel of St. Michael, Pine Island and Patrick Norton, speaking on Sister Annella Zervas, O.S.B. and St. Mother Teresa.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE REPORTS

NCCW Associates – Chris Heiderscheidt reported that the Associates of NCCW funded zoom so the Province Directors could meet virtually

NCCW Nominating Committee – Bev McCarvel reported on Marla Johnston being re-elected as NCCW Treasurer. They currently seek nominees for President-elect, Secretary and Nominating Committee Members.

Friends of NCCW for WUCWO – Maribeth Stewart is encouraging fundraising for African Women on WUCWO website. The WUCWO General Assembly will be held May 2023 in Assisi, Italy, postponed a year due to Covid. The General Assembly is held every 4 years: 2010 was in Jerusalem (Joan McGrath and Connie Andrews attended); 2014 was in Fatima, Portugal (Marge Sehnert);

2018 was in Senegal, Africa (Lucy Johnson). Friends will celebrate their 20th anniversary during their annual breakfast meeting on Saturday, Nov. 5 at the NCCW Convention in Minneapolis
